### **ExpressJet Airlines, a United Express Carrier, Announces Houston as First Embraer E175 Crew Base**

**ATLANTA**, February 7, 2019 – ExpressJet Airlines, a United Express regional carrier, announced Houston’s George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH) as the first flight crew base for its new Embraer E175 fleet.

“Houston is a great place to live and is highly accessible for crew members who commute,” said Vice President of Flight Operations Greg Wooley. “We’re proud that it will be the first home for our E175s and look forward to announcing a second base location soon.”

ExpressJet is growing with 25 new E175s in 2019 and will hire more than 600 pilots this year alone.
